OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE MANUAL (translation of the original instruction)

1.1 Description

The **Markingenius MG4** is an industrial labelling printer designed to offer a very high quality and long-lasting printing for text, logos, electrical symbols, QR codes and all kinds of vector images. It is equipped with a ribbon save system, a useful function that allows you to consume only the ribbon needed for printing.

Its reliability and robustness mean that the MG4 can be used intensively, making it suitable for all kinds of applications. The large on-board touch screen enables quick and easy management of print projects.

All CEMBRE MG products print using Windows True Type fonts in black or colour, at very high speed. It is also possible to reproduce Clipart images, drawings, barcodes and bitmap images, including in very small sizes. Each monochrome ribbon can print more than 300,000 MG-TPMF 4x10 mm tags with full printable surface coverage, while printing times, costs and ribbon life may be further improved due to the ribbon optimisation system, depending on the type of material being printed. As the pigment deposited from the ribbon dries instantaneously, printed sheets are immediately ready to use.

Projects can be set up and created from a PC with the GENIUSPRO software for managing production orders or, if necessary, via the GENIUSPRO MOBILE APP developed by CEMBRE for IOS and Android devices (smartphones and tablets) for the latest changes on site, on the electrical panel or on the edge of the machine.



- Turn off all affected devices (computers, printers, accessories) before disconnecting cables.

1.6 Unpacking and installing the device

- ▶ Remove the contents from the box.
- ▶ Check that the printer has not been damaged in transit.
- ► Check that all package contents are present.
- ▶ Place the printer on a flat surface.



2.2 Connecting the device


The standard interfaces and connections are described in § 2.1.

2.2.1 Mains power supply and switching on

The printer is equipped with a broad spectrum power supply unit. Operation with a mains voltage of 230 V / 50 Hz or 115 V / 60 Hz is possible without any modification to the device.

- ▶ Make sure that the printer is switched off before connecting, switch (7) in position 0 (Fig. 5).
- ► Connect the power supply unit connector (D) to port (11) on the back of the printer.
- ► Connect the power cable to the connector (20) of the power supply unit and to an electrical outlet.
- ▶ Press the switch (7) so it is at position I to turn on the printer, after a short test cycle the initial screen will appear on the display (refer to § 3.1).

Only connect the power supply unit to electrical outlets with protective earth contact. The electrical outlet must be located near the printer and always be easily accessible when needed.



The printer can also be powered by a separate battery without being connected to the mains (see § 7).


Direct connection to a computer • 2.2.3

▶ Connect the USB cable from the computer to the connector (10) on the back of the printer and then proceed with the installation. The printer will be automatically installed and visible in the Control Panel, Devices and Printers of the PC.

- ► Connect the cable from the network to the Ethernet port (8) on the back of the printer.
- ► From the MG4 display, select: Setting >Network > LAN settings.
- ► Click on EDIT button (Enable DHCP if you want to use this automatic IP address assignment protocol, if DHCP is not used, disable it and manually enter the IP address).




- 2.2.4.1 ▶ Add the printer as a TCP/IP device on the PC, setting the IP address shown on the MG4 display, or the hostname (default = MG4-[printer serial number] e.g. MG4-20AA001).
 - Select CEMBRE S.P.A. in the Manufacturer column and then the MG4 driver in the Printer column. Click "Next" to complete the installation.


- ► From the MG4 display, select: Settings > Network
- Click on the edit button and select DHCP.
- Search for a select the desired Wi-Fi network and enter its password.
- Proceed as described in § 2.2.4.1.



Connection via an Access Point AP 2.2.6



- ► From the MG4 display, select: Network > Settings
- ► Activate the button in the top right-hand corner
- ▶ Click on the edit button and select ACCESS DHCP.
- Select the SSID network generated by the MG4, enter the password, or, in "Network Information", scan the QR code.
- ▶ Proceed as described in § 2.2.4.1.



2.2.7 Installing the "GENIUSPRO" operating software

- ► The USB flash drive (FD-GENIUSPRO) contains the "GENIUSPRO" operating software and the drivers necessary for the printer to function. Any updates to the "GENIUSPRO" software can be downloaded from the website www.cembre.com.
- ▶ Insert the USB drive into the computer's USB port and proceed with the installation of "GENIUSPRO" through the SETUP file.



2.2.8 Connection to the "Geniuspro Mobile" app

- ▶ Install the "Geniuspro Mobile" app on your Android or iOS mobile device (refer to § 1.1).
- ▶ Pair the MG4 to the app via an access point (proceed as described in section 2.2.6) or via a WiFi network. (proceed as described in § 2.2.5 verifying that the device is also connected to the WiFi network already connected to the MG4).
- ▶ Open the "Geniuspro Mobile" app, click on ▷ ADD PRINTERS.
- ▶ Enter in the "Network Information" menu of the MG4 and e scan the QRcode on the display via the mobile device, pairing the MG4.



10 3 Touch screen display

The user can control the operation of the printer with the touch screen display, for example:

- · Manage the print queue, stop, continue or cancel jobs.
- Set printing parameters, perform diagnostics of main functions and configure the interface, language and time.

The settings made on the touch screen display are used for the basic configuration of the printer.

The print settings are already configured for correct use and are protected by the security PIN: 0000

Note!

In case of standby (black screen), touch the screen to restore operation.



The touch screen display is operated by lightly tapping with a finger:






4.1 Positioning the interface template

To keep the print sheets in the correct position on the loading carriage, the latter must be equipped with a special interface template (Fig. 8a):

- ▶ Choose the interface template most suitable for the product to be printed (Ref. to table A).
- ► Correctly place the interface template (Fig. 8b) on the mobile carriage so that the two guide pins fit into the corresponding holes under the template.

4.2 Changing the print ribbon

To facilitate the unwinding of the ribbon, we recommend retracting the mobile carriage (5);





Fig. 9 Print ribbon path

- ▶ Remove the top lid (3) (Fig. 9a).
- ▶ Rotate the front media guide (15) completely downwards (Fig. 9b).
- ▶ Remove the ribbon take-up spool (13) by releasing it and lifting it up. Then insert the cardboard core (M) included in the supply (Fig. 9c).
- ▶ Pull out the ribbon take-up spool (14) by releasing it and raising it, thread the print ribbon through, aligning the slot with the reference pin on the spindle (Fig. 9c).
- ▶ Unroll the ribbon by passing it under the rear guide (18) (Fig. 9) and then under the print head (20) until it comes out on the opposite side (Fig. 9d).
- ▶ Pull the ribbon further so that it passes over the front guide (19) (Fig. 9).
- ▶ Tape the end of the print ribbon to the cardboard core of the spindle (13). We recommend that you wind the print ribbon tightly around the cardboard core for a few turns in order to achieve correct take-up.
- ▶ Then secure the spool (14) in place by pushing it fully into its seating (Fig. 9d).
- Lock the ribbon take-up spool (13) in place by pushing it all the way down so that the ribbon is taut (Fig. 9d).
- ► Turn the front media guide (15) completely upwards.
- ► Replace the upper lid (3).



Caution!

Ensure that the media guide is rotated fully upwards

Caution!

- Keep your hands away from the carriage area during printing.
- The printer will not start if the guard (3) is not correctly positioned.



Note!

To get the best printing results, we recommend following these rules:

- Only use genuine CEMBRE consumables (sheets, print ribbons, etc.).
- · Handle the sheets carefully once out of the package and avoid touching the print area with your fingers.
- · Before printing, always check that the sheets are free of dirt or residue. If necessary, clean the printing surface with a soft cloth.
- Keep the sheets to be printed inside their packaging in a dry and clean place.
- . When printing partially used sheets, make sure that there are no protruding burrs along the length of the sheets along the punching edges or upward facing plates that could damage the print head.
- When printing partially used sheets, make sure that you are using a print file that has been suitably modified for the number of sheets actually present on the sheet; executing a complete print with a partially used sheet could irreparably damage the print head.

5.1 **Printing process**

Manually load a sheet onto the interface template in order to block its movement; the striker feet under the sheet should match the holes in the template and the side stems should be facing the inside of the printer (Fig. 10).


After processing the print job using GENIUSPRO software, start printing.

The printing procedure includes the following phases:

1. The mobile carriage (1) retracts inside the printer.

- 2. The sheet is printed, then the carriage protrudes (1).
- 3. Manually remove the printed sheet from the template (Fig. 11).



6 Cleaning 19

6.1 Cleaning instructions



Danger!

Disconnect the printer from the mains before maintenance.

The printer only requires minimal care. However, it is important to regularly clean the thermal print head. This ensures consistently good print quality and plays a major role in preventing premature wear of the print head. For the rest, maintenance is limited to monthly cleaning of the device.



Caution!

Aggressive cleaning products may damage the printer!

Do not use abrasive products or solvents to clean the external surfaces or the units.

- ▶ Remove dust and print debris in the loader and print area with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner.
- Clean the external surfaces with a gentle detergent.

6.2 Cleaning the print head

How often to clean: after each ribbon spool replacement or as needed.

Dirt can accumulate on the print head during printing, affecting the print quality.



Caution!

Damage to the print head!

Do not use hard or abrasive objects to clean the print head.

Do not touch the protective glass layer of the print head.



Caution!

Risk of injury from the heat of the print head.

Before cleaning, make sure the print head has cooled down.

- ► Remove the ribbon from the printer.
- ▶ Clean the print head with a stick or a cotton swab dipped in pure alcohol.
- ▶ Allow the print head to dry for 2-3 minutes.

Accessories

7.1 Inserting/removing the batteries



Caution!

- Use only batteries specified by the Manufacturer Risk of fire or explosion if battery is replaced with an incorrect type.
- Only charge batteries with the charger specified by the Manufacturer.
- ▶ Protect batteries from water and moisture!
- Do not expose batteries to fire!
- Do not open batteries!



- create a connection between the contacts. Do not use defective or deformed batteries.
- A slightly acidic, flammable liquid may leak from defective lithium batteries. If battery fluid leaks from the battery and comes into contact with the skin, rinse immediately with plenty of water. If battery fluid comes into contact with the eyes, rinse with clean water and seek immediate medical attention.
- ► Always recycle batteries at the end of their life.
- Never dispose of batteries in household waste.
- ► They should be taken to the appropriate collection centres for disposal.





- Switch off the printer and disconnect the power supply.
- Remove the protective lid (5) of the contacts by pulling the release button (6) upwards (Fig. a).
- Insert the battery (O) from above by sliding it into the guides until it locks into place (Fig. b).




Note!

When you connect the power supply unit with the battery inserted in the printer, the power supply automatically switches to mains.

When the power supply unit is connected and supplied from the mains, it is advisable to remove the battery from the printer and protect the contacts with the lid (5).

The power supply unit does not function as a battery charger! The battery must only be charged using the charger provided by CEMBRE.

7.2 Battery autonomy


▶ The battery is equipped with LED indicators to show the remaining amount of charge at any time.

Press button (P):

4 LEDs on: fully charged 2 LEDs on: 50% charged

1 flashing LED: low battery, recharge

▶ The remaining charge can also be checked on the printer display



7.3 Using the battery charger

- ▶ Carefully follow the detailed instructions in the relevant user manual.
- ▶ The time for recharging a fully depleted battery (e.g. CB1852L) is approximately 100 min, using the charger type ASC55.
